




fin	Soft, flat parts of the body which help an animal to swim.	<p><b><u>Fish</u></b></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has scales</li> <li>Has fins</li> <li>Lays eggs</li> <li>Uses gills to breathe</li> </ul>	<p>An omnivore eats</p> 
hooves	The hard, lower part of the feet of some animals, such as horses.	<p><b><u>Reptile</u></b></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has dry scales</li> <li>Lays eggs</li> <li>Breathes using lungs</li> <li>Has a tail</li> </ul>	
scales	The small, flat pieces of hard skin that cover a reptile's or fish's body.	<p><b><u>Amphibian</u></b></p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Young breathe in water using gills</li> <li>Adults breathe on land using lungs</li> <li>Lays eggs</li> </ul>	
wing	The front limbs or 'arms' of a bird that it uses for flying.
