Year 1 Spring 2 Properties of Materials – Knowledge Organiser

VOCABULARY

properties	words that describe what something is like, such as hard, soft, shiny.
hard	solid, firm, not easy to break or bend.
soft	not hard or firm, gentle to the touch and easy to fold or cut.
rough	not even or smooth (a rough surface will be lumpy or bumpy to touch).
smooth	not rough or lumpy (you can run your finger over smooth surfaces easily).
dull	not bright or shiny.
shiny	bright and reflects light.
flexible	bends easily.
stretchy	slightly elastic and stretches easily (can be made longer or wider without tearing).
stiff	firm, not bendy.
opaque	cannot be seen through.
transparent	can be seen through.
waterproof	keeps water out.
absorbent	soaks up water (or other liquids)
