VOCABULARY	
Creation	Something that someone has made for the first time.
Creator	Used as a name to describe God as the maker of the universe.
Parable	A story used by Jesus, which teaches or explains an idea.
Temptation	Something you want to have or do, even though you know you shouldn't.
Genesis	A book or part of the Bible which talks about creation.
Christianity	A religion that believes God made the world
Christian	People who follow Christianity are called Christians.
Commandment	A rule that should be obeyed.
Reconciliation	When people make up after they have fallen out.

The Seven Days of Creation		
Day 1	light was created	
Day 2	the sky was created	
Day 3	dry land, seas, plants and trees were created	
Day 4	the Sun, Moon and stars were created to give light to the world	
Day 5	creatures that live in the sea and creatures that fly were created	
Day 6	animals that live on the land and finally humans, made in the image of God were created	
Day 7	God finished his work of creation and rested, making the seventh day a special holy day	

The Ten Commandments

Christians believe God gave humans guidelines for living to keep them close to him.

These guidelines are called the Ten Commandments.

The 10 Commandments

- 1** Love God more than you love anything else.
- 2** Don't make anything in your life more important than God.
- 3** Always say God's name with love and respect.
- 4** Honor God by resting on the seventh day of the week.
- 5** Love and respect your parents.
- 6** Don't hurt anyone.
- 7** Always be faithful to your husband or wife.
- 8** Don't take anything that isn't yours.
- 9** Always tell the truth.
- 10** Be content with what you have. Don't wish for other people's stuff.
