| Truce | An agreement which stops fighting or arguing where a conflict exists. |
| Refugee | A person who has been forced to leave their country in order to escape war, danger or natural disaster. |
| Conflict | A serious disagreement between people/countries which can lead to war. |
| Danger | The threat of something unpleasant happening which fills people with fear. |
